

Enrolment Policy

PURPOSE

Greenhills Primary School has an enrolment ceiling of 500 students to control the growing number of students electing to come to our school. The enrolment cap will limit the number of positions available at all grade levels and require a waiting list for students who do not reside in our local school area (closest state primary school).

GUIDELINES

The following enrolment restrictions and priorities are in place for enrolments at Greenhills Primary School.

- Enrolment numbers will be restricted to 500 students where possible.
- Priority placement will be allocated to students where geographically Greenhills is the closest state school to the child's primary residence Priority placement will be allocated to students with siblings already enrolled.
- Grade 1 to 6 enrolments of children who reside closer to another Primary School will be placed on a
 waiting list. Applications will be kept in the office based on the date of a completed enrolment form.

EVALUATION AND REVIEW

The Greenhills Primary Enrolment Policy will be evaluated annually on a minor basis and receive a major evaluation once every three years as per our school policy review.
