Next year, the Grade 6 children will have the opportunity of attending Burnside Camp at Anglesea. Facilities provided at this campsite are of an excellent standard.

The cost of this camp is \$560. This camp is an outdoor education camp. It covers activities such as swimming at the beach, canoeing, bike riding, high ropes, low ropes, flying fox and surfing. Most of these activities require the use of specialist camp staff as well as the hiring of equipment. In addition, due to the nature of these activities, we require a low adult/student ratio. Swimming at the beach, for example, requires a ratio of 1:5, as well as the hiring of trained lifeguards. As you can see, the overall enjoyment and safety of your child is of paramount importance to us.

With all of these fantastic activities and experiences offered, it is easy to see why this camp is considered one of the highlights of Greenhills students' primary years.

As we need to establish the number of campers to complete planning, we would appreciate if you could complete the attached permission & medical form, and return them to school with the **non-refundable deposit of \$110** (refundable only for medical reasons) by **Friday 15 November 2019**

To ease with payment of this camp, we are offering progress payments. Payment dates are as follows;

- Progress Payment - \$150 – by Friday 13/12/19

Activities within this program present the potential for students to sustain physical injury. The following procedures will be implemented – along with other strategies – to manage the potential risks in the program.

Most activities will be run by specialist camp staff, to ensure student safety. All activities risk has been assessed and appropriate safety equipment will be used throughout. All activities will adhere to the adult to student ratio. Teachers and camp staff are qualified to administer first aid.

A risk management plan for this program has been developed by staff and is available for parents to review on request.

Student behaviour
